



## E. Amendment to the Auckland Regional Navigation Safety Bylaws

### Purpose

The council is amending the Auckland Regional Council Navigation Safety bylaws by removing Schedule 7.1 Services and Fees from the bylaw and including in the annual plan process.

### Background

The Council sets fees and administrative charges for other services provided. The navigational safety service fees are removed from the bylaw to deal with fixing and reviewing these charges in accordance with other processes for setting fees and charges, rather than through an amendment to the bylaws.

### Change

Amendments to the Navigation Safety bylaws are:

- (i) deleting clause “5.3 Fees and Charges” and replacing with new clause “5.3 Fees and Charges. That fees and charges for functions undertaken by the Council under these bylaws are set out in the Auckland Regional Council’s Schedule of Fees and Administrative Charges. These fees and charges must be paid on demand by the specified person to the Council”.
- (ii) deleting schedule 7.1 Services and Fees.
- (iii) amending all clauses by deleting “in schedule 7.1 of these bylaws” and replacing with “in the Auckland Regional Council’s Schedule of Fees and Administrative Charges”.
- (iv) renumbering Schedule 7.2 Location Specific Information to 7.1, with consequential renumbering amendments to all clauses by deleting “Schedule 7.2” and substituting “Schedule 7.1”.

## Schedule of fees from 1 July 2008

Service	Fee
1. Planning, co-ordination, liaison and operations for events, licensing of hire craft	An amount not exceeding \$140 per hour for the time spent by any council officer, and an amount not exceeding \$250 per hour for the time of use for a Harbourmaster vessel.
2. Annual "all tide" swing mooring administration charge	As per part 3 in table A (right)
3. Annual "mud mooring" administration charge	As per part 1 in table A (right)
4. Annual privately owned pile mooring administration charge	\$123.00 per annum
5. Annual ARC pile mooring administration and facility lease charge	As per part 2 in table A (right)
6. Application and transfer for mooring site	\$50
7. Registration of personal water craft	\$35
8. Approval of pilot or pilot exempt master training scheme, approval of pilot or pilot exempt master operating manual, approval of Harbourmaster as required by bylaw, assessment of application for exemption from any part of the bylaw, assessment of hotwork notification to ensure adequate precautions and forbidding of hot work operations.	An amount not exceeding \$140 per hour for the time spent by any council officer.
